Particulars / Action Point	Action Taken
Students recommended new courses/topics as IT laws with legal feasibility of a business idea/plan, Tailwind and similar applications to automate/schedule publishing on social media. Hands-on experience of Warehousing and mining tools. Judgement on Start-ups, Delta4 theory etc.	Recommended courses do not match with the basic objective of the BBA (IT) Programme and are not incorporated in the program structure. The respective faculty for Data Warehousing and Data Mining do cover some hands on session using tools. This was decided after discussion with the PRC.
For Term I, Teachers recommended new courses/topics as •4 credit advanced digital marketing course Node.js, Angular •We have changed Course content long back in 2014 but till date changes are not applied in program structure. For Term II, Teachers recommended new courses/topics as Separate course on Six-sigma methodology, Design Thinking, Business Model Innovation, Advance spreadsheet topics like pivot table etc...	Digital Marketing as a 2 credit course is in the program structure.. Node.js, angular are not included as too much focus will be on technology and do not go with the basic objective of the BBA (IT) program. This was decided after discussion with the PRC. Six Sigma will be covered as a SWAYAM course along with fundamentals of Quality Management course in 6th Sem as a Flexi Credit course, Spreadsheet will be covered as a Value Added Course in the 3rd Sem. Business Model Innovation is a part of the business Modelling and Business Plan in Sem 2. Design Thinking in Sem 5. This was decided after discussion with the PRC.
For Term I, Alumni recommended new courses/topics as Introduction to IT Service Management (ITSM) / ITIL, Artificial intelligence, Machine Learning / Cloud Infrastructure Services. For Term II, No recommendation on new courses/topics from Alumni	Recommended courses will be covered as a part of the Flexi credit courses and Value Added Courses. This was decided after discussion with the PRC.

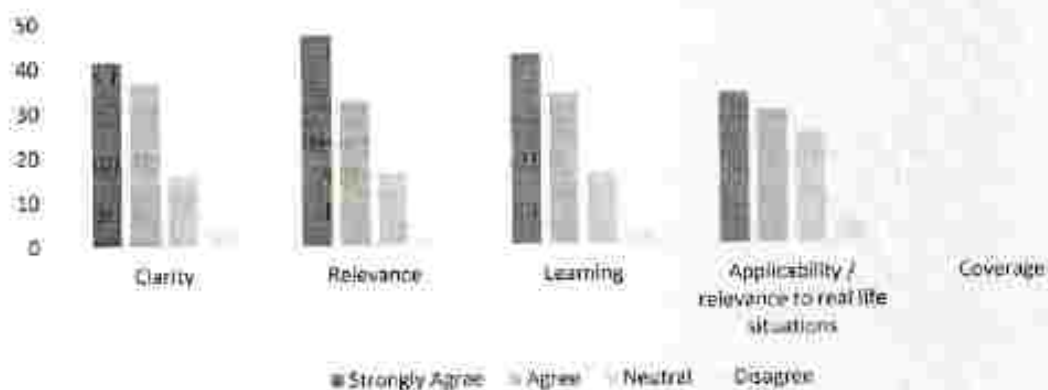

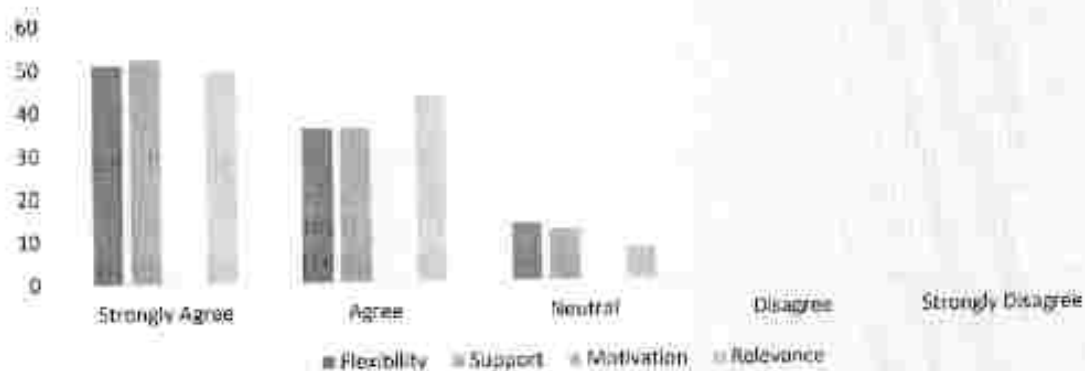

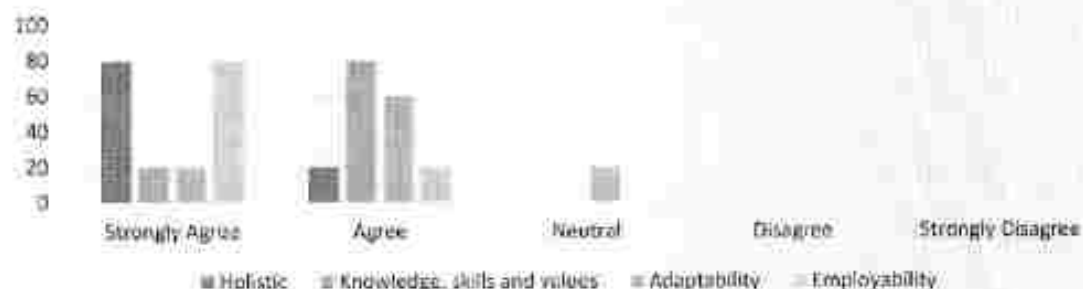
